**The Suit of Wands:** The element of Fire is the intuitive function in us, the spirit of creative vision that points you in a new direction or expansion of existing beliefs

This element has the added burden of pioneering or explorer that looks for and lives for the greater possibilities in life. Fire has a strong need to make things the best they can be, larger than life and is related to the Service function as it relates to pushing beyond what is known and expanding out into unexplored ideas, beliefs, territory and connections.

The positive side of Wands is the inspiration, story telling, magnetism and charisma that goes with the Fire suits in Astrology. There is an ability to enhance reality with color, drama and exaggeration that is highly persuasive and compelling.

It's shadow side is insensitive and egocentric especially around practical day to day necessities of life. To much common or repetitive functioning is like throwing dirt on the fire.

Fire is the opposite of sensory functions represented by Pentacles, it is contrasting to intuitive water/Cups and complimentary to the mental/Swords elements.

## **Ace of Wands**

- 1. A new start filled with energy and enthusiasm
- 2. It represents creation, beginning, fortune and adventure
- 3. Your dreams are manifesting, the seeds are planted and taking root. Be patient while they grow
- 4. Beginning a new job, career or way of life (combined with Ace of Pentacles, 8 of Pentacles, the Devil or Knight of Wands
- 5. Birth of a male child
- 6. Aces are always about new beginnings and the power of the individual applied to the element

This card is almost always a Yes in answer to any question

## **Two of Wands**

- 1. Need a partner to get the needed answer to an important question or to get the business or enterprise started
- 2. Waiting for shared ideas to take root and sprout
- 3. Travel card the Person will take a short trip near water
- 4. An offer, proposal or invitation of some kind may be presented to you
- 5. It doesn't say whether you accept or decline, merely that the invitation will be extended for a new beginning
- 6. Be sensitive to fears whenever you have a two it represents vulnerability
- 7. Twos are always about partnership and balancing the me versus we progression

Key timing associated with this card is March 21-30 and the answer to any question is yes with the right complimentary cards

### **Three of Wands**

- 1. Person is waiting for a need piece of information from a third party, missing pieces need to be filled in
- 2. Person is waiting for communication regarding the outcome of a business endeavor or enterprise
- 3. Someone knowledgeable could give the person needed help by message
- 4. Travel card the person could take a short trip over land
- 5. Threes are always about communication that helps or is needed to bridge gaps between people, places and things

Timing with this card is associated with March 31- April 10th and the answer to any question is likely yes look to the other cards to confirm

## **Four of Wands**

- 1. Person has a happy home with solid relationships
- 2. Marriage card (with Ace of Cups, 2 of cups, and/or Queen of Cups)
- 3. Person could be giving or going to a party or wedding
- 4. Remodeling a home to make it more beautiful (with Ace of Pentacles, 6 of pentacles, and or Empress)
- 5. Fours are always about putting things on a firm foundation or grounding it

Timing associated with this card is April 11-20th and the answer to a question is definitely a yes

### **Five of Wands**

- 1. A battle card indicating the person will have arguments, aggression and debates; but they should go for it because it's a battle they can win
- 2. Having the will to win or the person may force their will on another or others
- 3. The Situation calls for clarity create order out of chaos
- 4. A strenuous athletic competition playing 'up' in sports
- 5. Person will need to overcome obstacles (with the World)

Timing is associate with July 22nd - August 1st and the answer to any question is likely no - there is opposition at present

## Six of Wands

- 3. Person will receive recognition (with The Star)

- 5. Possible journey as a leader or representative of a company (in a reading with Pentacles)
- 6. Sixes are about wholeness, personal integrity and being having all that you need within yourself

Key timing associated with this card is August 2nd - 11th and the answer to any question is yes

### **Seven of Wands**

- 1. Person is on higher ground than they think they are because they are their own worst enemy
- 2. Person must hold their own against difficult odds and adversaries respect yourself and the other person for best outcome
- 3. Person feels they are battling alone for their ideals boundaries are required to stop needless battling
- 4. Person is very philosophical
- 5. Unorthodox behavior needs to conform (with the Heirophant)
- 6. Person is being unjustly attacked by others find a neutral and clear way to say what you need, feel and know

Key timing associated with this card is November 23rd through December 2nd and the answer to any question is likely yes - see surrounding cards to confirm

# **Eight of Wands**

- 2. Person is speeding towards an end that promises great reward
- 3. The person will achieve their goal if they remain focused and clear (with 7 of cups)
- 4. Travel across water for business (with the Knight of Wands and or the Chariot)
- 5. Expect Abundant opportunity
- 6. Eights are always what you put out there comes back to you

Key timing associated with this card is November 23rd to December 2nd and the answer to any question is definitely Yes

### **Nine of Wands**

- 1. Be prepared because eventual victory is around the corner
- 2. Victory and attainment are within sight but there is one more battle that must be won
- 3. If Attacked this person will fight fiercely
- 4. Hidden enemies require mental discipline to overcome (with The Moon)
- 5. Person must hold on to what they believe and see it through
- 6. This card always signals the final stages of something has been reached
- 7. A choice is always present whether to use raw anger or force or harness it for inspiration and motivation

- 8. In order to get to where you want, you have to delegate and find a rhythm that is more in tune with your path

- 3. There are challenges that will require you to stretch and grow in order to prevail
- 4. A change of endeavors (with the Devil or Death)
- 5. A change in relationship (with the Two of Cups)
- 6. Knights always signal movement and this is the bravest of the Knights active and bold

Key timing associated with this card is November 13 - December 12th and the answer to any question is Yes

### **Queen of Wands**

### As a Person:

- 1. A Fire Queen who is practical and has good intuitive sense
- 2. A loving and loyal woman who if rejected or wounded will retreat in pride
- 3. A woman who is sure of herself and in charge of the situation
- 4. The bigger world a woman who is happiest traveling or exploring new options

#### As a situation:

- 1. Success in business
- 2. May indicate a love of money and gifts
- 3. Can indicate a love affair rather than marriage
- 4. Queens always represent the feminine receptive principle of strength rather than power and with wands it signals inspiring others to follow her example
- 5. Timing is this queen's job so look to the other cards to see whether the timing is good or bad for the question

Key timing associated with this card is March 11th to April 10th and the answer to any question is Yes

## King of Wands

- 9. Kings are the masculine leadership potential within people the Wands mean an inspired leadership

### As a situation:

- 1. A good business sense or situation
- 2. Becoming a representative of high authority
- 3. Uniting opposite business interests

### The Suit of Pentacles

The suit of Pentacles are associated with the element of Earth and represent life energy expressed through sensory functions. It is the basic element we all share, the body. As such it is one that universally connects us all.

This suit is associated with practicality, efficiency, common sense and realistic, organized, tangible results. This is where we learn by doing rather than books or feelings. It often signifies health or the lack of it and the state of the body or the world you inhabit. This suit is the manifesting suit, the one that shows whether or not you are making things happen or making measurable progress.

The positive side is actualizing desires, getting results, someone at home in their body and their world, sensuality and practical logical attitudes. It's shadow side is lack of intuitive trust in what it cannot see, touch, taste, hear or smell. They can be slow or resistant to change letting fear keep them in familiar and safe patterns for long periods of time.

The Pentacles are complimentary to Water/Cups, contrasting with Air/Swords and is opposite Fire/ Intuition.

### **Ace of Pentacles**

- 1. The start of new wealth
- 2. A new opportunity
- 3. An increase in money (with the 6 of Pentacles)
- 4. Money spent on expensive items (with the 3 or 6 of Pentacles and/or The Chariot)
- 5. A lot of money is coming in (with the Empress or the 9 of Pentacles)
- 6. The Ace of Pentacles represents the seed that is ready to bloom which expresses' your creativity and desire to start something new
- 7. The beginning stages of self-confidence that expresses externally
- 8. The new start of a long awaited dream connected to health, stability finding your contentment in life
- 9. Tangible steps towards your new life
- 10. Aces are always about new beginnings and the power of the individual applied to the element

This card tends to signal a Yes to any question

### **Two of Pentacles**

- 1. Juggling competing priorities or two things at the same time focus on your intent and stay grounded in the moment
- 2. Attempting to balance the budget a changing money situation
- 3. Fluctuating financial matters
- 4. Watch your money you could experience a small theft
- 5. Income from a second source (with the Knight of Pentacles)

### **Three of Pentacles**

- 2. Apprenticeship, learning a new skill or trade
- 3. Car Problems (with travel cards like Knight of Wands, Page of Wands)
- 4. Skill and ability in trade are rewarded
- 5. Appraisal and constructive criticism of a person's work (with Judgement)
- 6. Three's always represent communication, pentacles tangible results so the combination speaks to constructive conversation that yields measurable outcomes

Key timing with this card is associate with December 31st - January 9th and the answer to any question is a yes

## **King of Pentacles**

**The Suit of Cups:** These are associated with the element of water and represent emotions, love or psychic things. This is the suit most concerned with relationships and human values.

This suit is one where sacrifice of self for another shows up. Connection is the most valued currency even at one's own expense. This suit is fluid and often reflects a wave in and out of emotions. Fluctuations are common and part of the experience.

Cups have a sensitivity to atmosphere and are always influenced by the cards around them. Cups have the capacity to dissolve boundaries, bring people and situations to a natural bonding points and the ability to instinctively read others needs and feelings.

On the shadow side there is possessiveness, a tendency towards emotional extreme highs and lows, fearful of loss, gushing sentimentality and romantic escapism.

Water is complimentary with Earth/Pentacles is contrasting with Fire/Wands and is opposite the Mind/Swords in a reading.
